Florida Building Code brings a property to 80% of LEED Standard Requirements

- Impact of Irma: businesses begin to understand value of building code and stringent standards to resilience
- Emphasis on strategic planning inclusive of resilience, coop, continuity of Operations planning.

- Relationships to & with State are strong but greater buy in from State is needed
- © Greater understanding of local issues to be enforced by greater homerule

- Real Estate developers and managers encouraged to conduct vulnerability assessments on multi unit private residences
- Large Developments maintain Resiliency as a marginal concern, SLR/flood risk not a priority in financial analytics of major developers
- Why: insufficiently informed or not concerned...both... Development Industry needs to be informed and brought onboard through greater buy in of the need for resilience and adaptations
- On SLR, for example, how to generate buy in for the Compact's Projections by industries like Comm. Dev & real estate

- Resilient Naturescapes: restoring landscaped to naturally resilient states, focus of The Nature Conservancy
- Resilience Bonds: quantify value of resiliency implementations

- Explore Organizations like Resiliency Florida
- Rep Jacobs need for policy revisions to align solar access and investment as well as the sell back of excess power
- Support for PACE financing
- Intro of credit scores relevant to resiliency and climate preparedness

- Resilience of LI communities and other vulnerable pops like seniors n homeless. Senator Corchran Select Committee to address above discussed by Rep Jacobs
- Question of Public Health institutions such as hospitals and nursing homes, same issue as seniors in general and resource/outreach networks for resilience of vulnerable populations; strong push to harden facilities to secure them to shelter in place

- 200,000 Puerto Rican climate migrants in Central Florida,
 - > lack of infrastructure
 - lack of preparedness
 - trend expected to continue as coast is more pressured
 - What are the implications in Monroe County?
 - Experience of Key West after Haitian Earthquake, changing social demographics

 - Scalability Collaborate upward start local and build bridges of collaboration out n up to broader region

- Mass: state of equity report, move to minimize marginalization
- NOLA: assessed who is getting which jobs i.e., moving up economic scales, presented to higher education institutions- urban water certificate program developed
